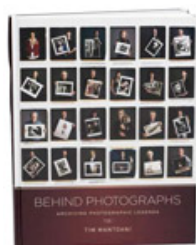

it an extra Gothic sheen.

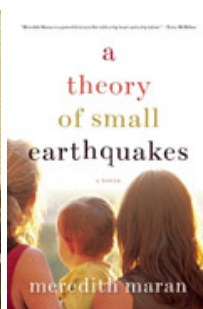


### Grace

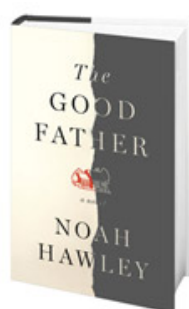
